### SET OF INFLATABLE CAMPER BED WITH PUMP AND SHEET

### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Before using the product for the first time, familiarize yourself with it. Carefully read the following instructions and safety warnings. Use the product only as described and only for the specified purposes. Keep these instructions in a safe place. If passing the product on to third parties, ensure that you also provide all accompanying documentation.

#### The set includes:

- 1. Inflatable bed
- 2. Electric pump
- 3. Sheet
- 4. Bag for the set

## **WARNINGS**

- 1. If you open the packaging carelessly with a sharp knife or other pointed objects, you could easily damage the inflatable mattress.
- 2. Open the packaging very carefully.
- 3. Remove the inflatable mattress from the packaging.
- 4. Check that all parts are included in the set.
- 5. Check the inflatable mattress and its parts for any visible damage. If any damage is found, do not use the inflatable mattress.
- 6. Ensure that children do not play with the packaging film or storage bag, as they can get trapped and suffocate.

# **INFLATABLE BED**

#### **INTENDED USE**

The inflatable mattress is designed exclusively for resting/sleeping. It is intended solely for private use, not for commercial purposes. Use the inflatable mattress only as described in the instructions for use. Any other use is considered improper and may result in material damage or personal injury. Do not step on the inflatable mattress or use it as a trampoline. The inflatable mattress is not a toy. The manufacturer or seller assumes no liability for damage caused by improper or incorrect use.

Maximum load: 100 kg

Maximum inflation pressure: 0,24 bar



It is placed on the reversed driver and passenger seats, as well as the second-row bench. Three handles make installation easier. The maximum load capacity of the mattress is 100 kg. Once installed, the mattress does not obstruct movement inside the vehicle.



## **INFLATING AND DEFLATING**

- 1. The valve has two threads. For inflation, unscrew the top cap and insert the hose from the electric pump into the valve.
- 2. Inflate the mattress not more than to a pressure of 0,24 bar. Once the pressure is reached, remove the hose (the valve is self-sealing and will not release air) and screw the protective cap back on.
  - a) When filling, please note that higher pressure means greater stiffness of the mattress, but also a harder base. Thus, for use with less than 50 kg of load, a pressure of 0,10-0,15 bar is recommended. Load up to 80 kg: 0,20 bar and load up to 100 kg: 0,24 bar

- b) When filling, please note that the first filling in the use of the mattress may cause slight expansion of the material and it may need to be filled additionally if necessary. This will not happen with subsequent fillings.
- c) Pressure may also drop if the mattress is filled at a significantly higher temperature (in summer, in the middle of the day) than it is used (night). In this case, top up if necessary, but make sure that the maximum permissible pressure is not exceeded.
- 3. For deflation, unscrew the second thread (closer to the mattress) to allow rapid deflation.

# **CLEANING AND STORAGE**


- 1. If the product becomes dirty, gently wipe its surface with a clean, damp cloth. Do not use aggressive cleaning agents.
- 2. Once the product is completely dry, fold it (ensuring no sharp folds or corners form) and store it in the transport bag.
- 3. Before storing the product, squeeze out all the air. Store it in a cool, dry place out of reach of children.
- 4. Before each use, check the product for potential damage, and inspect it regularly during use.
- 5. Do not place sharp or heavy objects near or on the bed, as they may damage or tear the product.

#### WARNINGS

- 1. Keep away from fire.
- 2. Do not overinflate beyond the specified pressure.
- 3. Do not use high-pressure or compressed air systems for inflation.
- 4. Do not use a hairdryer for inflation.
- 5. Do not place the product on uneven ground. Keep away from sharp objects that may puncture the product.
- 6. This product is not intended for use as a flotation device, swimming aid, or rescue apparatus.
- 7. This product is a sleeping surface. Jumping, walking, or playing on the product may cause personal injury and damage to the product.
- 8. This product is not suitable for infants or persons with limited mobility.
- 9. The inflatable bed is not a toy, and children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with it or the valve.
- 10. Never leave children unsupervised.

# **ELECTRIC PUMP**

The electric pump is powered via a 12-V car charger with a nominal rating of 5V / 2A.



For the pump to operate, the car must be on or in accessory mode.

Among the attachments, find the one that fits snugly into the inflatable bed's valve and attach it to the hose on one side and the bed's valve on the other.

Turn on the pump and inflate the mattress to a pressure of 0,24 bar.

## **WARNINGS**

- 1. If the power cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, their authorized service provider, or similarly qualified personnel to avoid potential hazards.
- 2. The motor should not run for more than 5 minutes. Before reusing, allow the motor to cool for approximately 5 minutes.
- 3. The device should not be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or those lacking experience and knowledge, unless under supervision or following instructions from a responsible person. Children should be supervised to prevent them from playing with the device.
- 4. WARNING: If using this product outdoors and/or in water, certain risks exist. Keep away from fire.
- 5. To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not expose the product to water or rain.

### **DISPOSAL OF THE PUMP**

Do not dispose of electrical equipment with household waste. If possible, recycle it. For recycling, consult local authorities or an authorized dealer.
